Emergency Room

- Non-life-threatening issues
- Not a replacement for a primary care doctor
- Cost depends on insurance coverage
- Business hours vary

- Immediate life-threatening emergencies
- Treats critical physical and mental concerns
- Accepts patients without insurance
- Open 24/7

Pediatric Urgent Care Visit

- Abdominal pains
- Allergic reaction to stings, bites, foods, medicine
- Asthma
- Animal bites
- Broken bones, sprains
- Cold/Flu
- Pink eye
- Rash
- Tonsillitis
- Urinary Burning
- Vomiting/Diarrhea
- X-Ray for head injury, extremity, rib fracture



Adult Urgent Care Visit

- Fever without rash
- Abdominal pains
- Allergic reactions
- Back pains
- Pink eye
- Dehydration
- Ear infections
- Insect bites/Cuts
- Migraines
- Mono
- Pneumonia
- STD/STI
- Sinusitis
- Upper respiratory infection
- Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Wounds



Pediatric Emergency Room Visit

- Severe/Life-threatening injury or illness
- Difficulty breathing
- Excessive bleeding (after 15 minutes of applied pressure)
- Fever over 100.4 in children under 2 months, more than 102 for toddlers
- Head injuries
- Severe headaches
- Seizures
- Serious burns
- Slurred speech, unable to move, trouble speaking
- Suspected physical or sexual abuse
- Swallowed large object



Adult Emergency Room Visit

- Seizures
- Heart attacks
- Fractures where bones break through skin
- Coughing/Vomiting blood
- Difficulty breathing
- Chest pains
- Psychiatric emergencies
- Severe allergic reactions
- Stroke/Stroke symptoms (facial drooping, slurred speech, weakness in arm and leg)
- Vaginal bleeding during pregnancy
- Serious burns
- Head injuries
- Loss of consciousness
