



1st Grade Supplies:

- 1 small plastic pencil box (size: 8.5x2.5x5.5)
- 3 vinyl double pocket folders with pockets on the bottom.
 - (1 yellow, 1 red, 1 blue) *solid only*
- 2 boxes of #2 yellow pencils sharpened (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 4 boxes of Crayola crayons – 24 count
- 1 10-pack thick Crayola washable markers
- 6 Elmer's glue sticks – **large**
- 1 pair of blunt tipped scissors (Fiskars brand preferred)
- 1 three pack of large pink erasers (no pencil top erasers)
- 2 packs thick black Expo dry erase markers
- 1 pair of over-the-ear headphones (earbuds are not recommended for this age group) in Ziploc Bag
- 1 folder with 3 prongs for Spring Math

*Amazon has great inexpensive ones (please note headphones may need to be replaced throughout the year)

- Please provide an extra pair of clothes for your child in case of accidents, labeled in a Ziploc bag
- Optional: gallon bags or sandwich bags



2nd Grade Supplies:

PENCILS: 3 dozen **YELLOW** (nothing fancy) SHARPENED pencils

****No mechanical pencils****

GLUE STICKS: 3 LARGE glue sticks OR 8-10 SMALL glue sticks

SCISSORS: 1 pair LABELED

2-POCKET FOLDERS: 2 **VINYL/PLASTIC**: 1 Red, 1 Blue (NOT paper-type)

COMPOSITION BOOK: 2 books (any color) (wide or college-ruled)

HIGHLIGHTER: 1 **YELLOW large**, not pen-type

ZIPPERED POUCH: LARGE enough to hold a box of 24 crayons, scissors and glue stick (buy an extra while on sale)

CRAYONS: 2 boxes, 24-pack, CRAYOLA brand (***Crayola brand only please***)

MARKERS: 1 box, 10 pack, CRAYOLA WASHABLE BROAD tipped (no skinny ones)

EXPO: 6 markers, BLACK ONLY, broad/chisel tips (not the skinny, pen-type)

HEADPHONES, **not Earbuds** (**must be corded** for Chromebooks!)

1-2 containers of Clorox wipes

1 folder with 3 prongs for Spring Math, box of expo markers

EXTRA:

Coloring/Activity book – for snack/indoor recess

Please note: **ALL supplies should be labeled with the student's name.**

Additional items may be requested at the start of the year if your child receives special services (Core Up, Learning Support, Speech, etc.)



3rd Grade Supplies:
