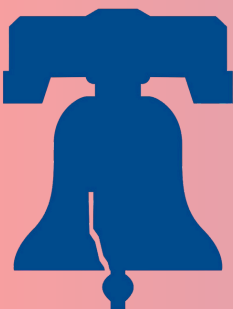


The Induction Ceremony of Interboro's Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society was held at IHS on May 16th.

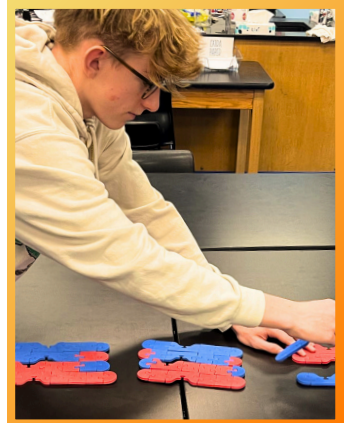

Modeling is at the heart of implementation of the Next Generation Science Standards."
