Board Vice President Tom Kiely







"3D molecular models provide hands on learning for all students, regardless of their instructional level. Students are able to explore models of biological processes that promote questions, conversation, and collaboration. Using models allows students to make deeper connections to topics that are traditionally difficult to understand. Students have a difficult time understanding cellular processes because they aren't something that they can see with the naked eve. Modeling is at the heart of implementation of the Next Generation Science Standards."
